Try to start doing the normal things of life that have nothing to do with your past experiences of trauma. The symptoms of post-traumatic stress, although normal in themselves, become a problem – or Post-traumatic Stress Disorder – when they go on for too long. This preoccupation allows them to feel safe, and to trust their own capacity Post Traumatic School Disorder accomplishing tasks.

For example, a child with PTSD may become less verbal, or begin thumb sucking again. Children and teens usually show symptoms more like those seen in adults. They might imagine riding in the car and then touch the car.
